

## Annual Report 2021-22

What we teach in this institution is backed not only by our honest effort but also brilliant results.** The session 2022-23 began with a cloud of COVID confusion but Nischalites have once again proven to be shining stars in this sky.
- Our school result in Board examination has been 100% for the session 2021-22 both at secondary and senior secondary level.

In class X, 130 students got merit and 47 students scored more than 90%. Vedika Gupta topped the class with 98.2%

In class XII, 100 students bagged merit and 29 students got more than 90%.

Akshita Aggarwal from commerce got 96.8%

Abhishek from medical got 96%

And Ankit from Non-medical got 95.6%

9 students got a perfect score of 100 in Music

- Dhruv Khanna secured 99.24% in JEE Mains Phase 1 examination and LakshayDhall got 96.8%.
- AbhishekKaushik and AnushkaSaluja scored sterling percentile of 99.7 and 99.8 in NEET Exam this year.
- Our school team qualified for the Zonal Science Quiz held at S.D. Sr. Sec. School this year and also got 4th position at State level.

A cash award of Rs. 5000 was bagged by every team member in the same quiz last year.

Following the footsteps of our worthy secretary Dr. Rupinder, 400 students from all classes participated in **the Annual science exhibition** where they showcased 300 models to bring into reality his vision of green science.

In accordance with the faith of our institution, we are also commemorating martyrdom day tomorrow **as Veer Bal Diwas** in our school premises in collaboration with Oat Aasra Sewa Society,

a group of young volunteers who are also proud Nischalites.

- **Putting in diligent efforts into holistic development of all the students has been our top priority in this session.** We coordinated with schools around the district to encourage a healthy competitive spirit.
- Angad Almadi and Mannat Dua of Class 5 wrapped up Ist and IIIrd position in the Inter School English Debate held at M.L.N. Public School.
- In the same school, Kartik Srivastava of Class V bagged Ist position in Inter School Hindi Declamation.
- Tanmay Sharma bagged first prize in Hindi poetry recitation competition held at S.V.N. Huda.
- Ryma Taneja of Class II was adjudged as Best Orator in D.A.V. College.

Our school hosted the 27th Inter School English debate and Hindi declamation for over 30 schools around the district.

We got 4 positions and an overall trophy for English Debate and Hindi Declamation as well.
